We are super excited to welcome you to Yeovil. Please ensure you read the race information carefully.

### Number Collection

**Your race packs will not be posted to you!**

Please collect your Race Number on the morning of the race from Race HQ, South Street, Yeovil <https://w3w.co/dish.trip.grab> between 07:00 and 08:45am

If you are able and would prefer to collect your number before race day - you can do so from the following locations:

Cow and Apple Restaurant at the top of the Quedam Shopping Centre, Yeovil, BA20 1EX between 12:00 and 16:30

### Getting There and Car Parking

There are several [CAR PARKS](#) in the centre of Yeovil, many of which are free of charge on a Sunday. **Please note Petters Way Carpark and the Market Carpark will be closed to entrants and the public on race day.** We recommend you carshare where possible and we advise you leave enough time to get parked.

### Race Numbers and Timing Chips

Please ensure you fill in the medical/ emergency information on the reverse of your race number. This information is invaluable in the unlikely event of an incident. It takes just a minute to fill it in and helps the medics in the event of an incident.

Your timing chip will be incorporated into your race bib. Please do not remove it, fold it or put pins through it. The timing chips will ensure that your finish time is recorded in the results.

**Your race number must be pinned to the FRONT of your running top**, please bring your own safety pins if you have them. Failure to start and finish wearing your race number will result in no time or position being recorded.

### Personalise your Race Bib

We have added a box on the race bib for you to write in your name / nick name or any other name that you would like spectators to shout out on the route to give you support and encouragement!



### **Bag Drop**

**If possible, please leave any belongings in your car.** There will be **limited** facilities for belongings to be left in Newnam Chapel Lounge at the Baptist Church (Lower Ground Floor) close to Race HQ. Your race number has a detachable baggage number attached, please attach this to your bag.

All items are left entirely at the owner's risk, the race organisers accept no responsibility for loss or damage. To avoid our volunteers waiting around for you, **please can you collect your belongings as soon as possible after you finish the race.**

### **Toilets**

Temporary toilets and urinals will be placed in the Short Stay carpark close to Race HQ. There are permanent toilets available in the Petters Way Long Stay car park nearby (**carpark closed to vehicles**).

### **Start Line, Race Briefing**

**Please Note** The race will start on the High Street opposite the Borough. Please assemble on South Street <https://w3w.co/showed.warm.puppy> There will be a race briefing at 9:15am or as soon as the Half Marathon sweepers have passed through.

The official race results will be 'Gun to Chip' so when assembling for the start, please ensure you get to the front if you expect to be fast. Race times will also be recorded 'Chip to Chip' (the time it takes you to get to the start line after the klaxon, will be factored out). **The race will start at 09:30 prompt.**

### **The Course**

The course is entirely on road/ tarmac and is mainly flat and fast. The route will be clearly marked and marshalled.

### **Pacers**

The RaceNation Events volunteer pacers will be present to help you get around the course in a certain time, they will be easily recognisable wearing orange pacer t-shirts. Feel free to have a chat with them before the race if you are hoping to stick with them, they'll be happy to answer any questions you may have. The pacer times are 38 | 40 | 42 | 45 | 48 | 50 | 52 | 55 | 58 | 60 | 62 | 65 | 70 | 75

### **Water Stations**

There will be one water station on Bunford Lane at approximately the halfway point. Water in recyclable cups will be provided to all runners, if you are carrying your own drinking vessel, one of the amazing volunteers will gladly fill it for you.

### **Medical Assistance**

Medical assistance is being provided by Tiger Stripe Events, please let a marshal know if you require assistance, there will be assistance at the finish if required.

### **Marshals**

If any of your friends and family would like to assist as a race marshal for the morning, please email [info@racenationalevents.com](mailto:info@racenationalevents.com) We would be delighted to have them as part of the team.

Likewise, if you develop an injury and can no longer race on the day, why not volunteer to marshal at the event and receive race credit for a future event.

### **Event Photos**

### **Transfers, Refunds and Deferrals**

There will be no transfers, deferrals, and no refunds at this late stage as per our T&C's. **Please do not email any requests at this stage as these will not be responded to.**

**Anyone having clearly swapped numbers will be excluded from the results and disqualified.**

## Runner Safety

Please note that the race is run on public roads, please bear this in mind and adhere to the Highway Code at all times. Runners should take great care and heed any instructions from Event Officials and Marshals, particularly at road junctions and roundabouts. Please run on the pavements where told to.

If you see a fellow runner in difficulty or distress, please relay the situation to the next marshal location.

In the event of any major occurrences along the route, the Race Director, Course Managers, Race Organiser and the emergency services reserve the right to alter or stop the event as necessary. This would be in circumstances beyond our control, no refunds will be given.

## Race Cut-Off Time

We will apply a race cut-off time of 100 minutes.

We will be standing down marshals and any road closures will be lifted from this point. Anybody left on the course at this stage can be retrieved by the sweeper vehicle if required.

## Using Headphones Whilst Running

UKA Rule T55 S5 permits the use of bone conducting headphones only. For this event we **WILL** allow the use of Bone Conducting Headphones, but **we will NOT allow the use of in ear headphones or those that are not bone conducting**. The Event Organisers will have no responsibility should this rule be ignored. Please do not risk our ability to be granted a future licence. **Any runner seen to be wearing in ear headphones will be disqualified by the Event Organisers.**

## Race Details

## Important Rules

The race is to be run under Licence from England Athletics. Any abuse of a race marshal, member of the public or other road user will not be tolerated. **Absolutely no litter is to be dropped on the course, if you can carry a full gel, you can carry an empty gel. Any violation of the rules will result in disqualification.**

## Race Results

Event timing is being carried out by DB Max Sports Timing. Race results will be available to view online once you record a finish time. All results remain provisional for 72 hours to allow the timing team to respond to any queries.

## Awards Presentation

Prizes will be presented, at approximately 11:00/ 11:30hrs, near to the finish, to the top three male and female finishers, we will also present age category prizes to the fastest male and female in each category - U20 | 40-49 | 50-59 | 60-69 | 70-79 | 80+

## Spectators

This is a great event for spectators, we recommend watching from the start and finish on the High Street.

## Dogs

Under UKA rules, dogs are not permitted at this event.

## Litter

Please dispose of any litter at the finish area in the bins provided or take it home with you, **please do not drop any litter on the ground.**
